

The Roberta Wright-Reeves Endowed Scholarship

The Roberta Wright Reeves Trust Endowed Scholarship Fund was established in 2002.

Roberta Wright Reeves was the daughter of Gilbert Greer Wright and Dela Slaughter Wright. G.G. Wright was a prominent attorney in Dallas. Mrs. Reeves' grandfather Col. C.C. Slaughter, Cattleman and Baptist, had extensive ranch land in Western Texas surrounding what is now Wayland Baptist University.

Mrs. Reeves was well known in social and charitable circles in Dallas. She gave of her own time and energies to the service of others. Education was of great importance to her, as she provided financial help to students during her lifetime. Mrs. Reeves died on May 13, 1989, in Dallas at the age of ninety-eight years.
